The Town of New Market (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

Water System Improvements

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at 9418 John Sevier Road, New Market, Virginia 22844 until **Monday, May 12th, 2025**, at **2:00 PM** local time. At that time the Bids received will be **publicly** opened and read at the Town of New Market Municipal Building located at 9418 John Sevier Road, New Market, VA 22844.

The Project includes the following Work:

Construction of two, new 500,000-gallon glass-lined bolted steel or welded steel potable water (ground level) storage tanks and approximately 560 linear feet of 16-inch ductile iron water main. Project is inclusive of associated site improvements, yard piping, stormwater improvements, grading, concrete, maintenance of traffic, erosion and sediment control, electrical, instrumentation, and associated appurtenances.

Bids are requested for the following Contract: **Water System Improvements**

Withdrawal of Bids

The procedure for withdrawal of bids shall be according to Section 2.2-4330 of the Code of Virginia.

Contract Award

Contract is to be awarded on the basis of lowest responsive and responsible bid.

- Compliance with the President’s Executive Order #11246
- Bidder certification that they do not or will not maintain or provide for their employees any facilities that are segregated
- Compliance with the President’s Executive Orders #12138 and #11625 regarding utilization of MBE/WBE
- Compliance with the Civil Rights Act of 1964
- Compliance with the Davis-Bacon Act
- Compliance with Section 436 of P.L. 113-76 American Iron and Steel
